## FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

- There will be prize money awarded on the **KINGS & QUEENS FEATURE RACE WHICH IS DECIDED FROM POINTS FROM PRO 450 CLASS AND RUNOVER 3 FINALS.**
- IF ANY CHEQUES ARE DISHONoured, THE ENTRANT/COMPETOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYMENT OF ANY FEES CHARGED TO THE CLUB.
- Entries close last mail Sunday 5<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2018.
- The ACTMCC being the promoter of this event reserves the right to refuse the entry of a person or persons from this event.
- Late entries may be accepted at the Race Secretary's discretion along with a fee.

## LICENCES

Can be National, Club or One Event (day) licences (day licences are \$90 and must be paid along with entry fee).

## AWARDS

KINGS & QUEENS trophies will be awarded to the top three point scorers in each class with 6 or more competitors. Prize money and Trophies for KINGS & QUEENS Feature race 1<sup>st</sup> \$1000, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$500, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$250.

THERE WILL BE A SHOOTOUT FOR SENIORS TOP 12 IN THE PRO 450 AT THE END OF SAT 1<sup>st</sup> \$750 AND JUNIOR LITES WILL HAVE A SHOOTOUT 1<sup>ST</sup> \$150, 2<sup>ND</sup> \$100, 3<sup>RD</sup> \$50 IN VOUCHERS.

## ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS

- To constitute a Class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each Class shall be a minimum of 6 solo or 3 or more for sidecars for classes. For KINGS & QUEENS feature class with prize money minimum of 12 Solo's.
- Should there be insufficient entries in any Class of Competition, the decision to run or cancel the Class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards, will be at the discretion of the Promoter.

## RACE FORMAT

### Saturday

We will run 1 round of practice on the LONG TRACK then 3 rounds of racing.

### Sunday

WE WILL RUN 2 rounds of racing/finals on the long track Sunday, All Finals and Cup feature races will be run on the long track.

- There will be 5 rounds of Racing for all classes with one grid of riders or less. For classes with more than one grid of riders there will be 4 rounds of racing with the top 10 point scorers from those rounds INTO FINAL THEN A REPERCHARGE WITH TOP 2 GOING INTO FINAL, competing in a one race final, there will be a B final for those that didn't make final.
- Finishing order in heats will determine the qualifying position which will determine your gate draw in all finals.
- Practice will be 2 laps, Races/Heats will be 3 laps
- Kings & queens Feature's will be decided by points from the pro 450 class and will then have 3 finals to decide on 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> placings over 5 laps.
- Scoring will be as per GCR's for Track
- SHOOT OUTS WILL RUN SAT AFTERNOON
- Nippers and junior trail bike classes will only be run on the sat.

## MACHINES AND RIDERS

- All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for Track.
- Multiple entry of the one Machine in the same Class of Competition is not permitted.
- Riders wishing to change machine must seek permission from the Clerk of the Course, however the same machine must be ridden in any final as was ridden in the qualifying heat for that final.

## RIDING NUMBERS

- Competitors will be allocated their MNSW Registered Riding Number or their preferred Riding Number. All others shall be allocated numbers at the *Promoter's* discretion.
- All Number Plates on all Machines MUST comply with the GCR's.
- **Back Number's MUST be clearly displayed on riders back.** The GCR'S state "back numbers MUST be worn or you cannot compete.

## GRID POSITIONS

- WILL BE PRE-ALLOCATED IN PROGRAM
- Finishing order in heats will determine your gate draw in your finals.

## RIDERS BRIEFING

A Riders' Briefing will be held prior to the commencement of practice and ALL Competitors MUST attend on both Saturday and Sunday.

## CODE OF CONDUCT

All Competitors, Officials and Parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all Motorcycle Race Meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and shall be enforced.

## **PITS:**

Trailers only to be in pit area, you may Drive in and Drop trailer off.

No one under 16yrs to be in pit area unless they are a competer.

No One to be in start area.

NO SMOKING IN PIT AREA

NO OPEN FOOTWEAR

## **TIMETABLE**

**Saturday:** Gates open at 6.30am. Sign on and Scrutineering 7am till 8.30am, Riders Briefing 8.45am, Practice 9am and Racing ASAP after Practice. Sat 1 round practice and 3 rounds racing on LONG TRACK.

**Sunday:** Gates open at 6.30am, riders briefing at 8.30am, NO PRACTICE SUNDAY, racing at 9.00am Sunday 2 rounds racing and for classes with heats 1 round of racing then Repechages and finals on the long track. There will be no need to resign on or have your bike scrutineered unless the bike was involved in an accident on the Saturday.

## **CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION**

620-Metre-long track constructed of composed granite on track.

## **STARTS**

Will be a 12-rider grid with Speedway Style Tapes Starting procedure will be confirmed at Riders Briefing.

## **NOISE**

All machines must comply with the requirements of the GCR's and the ACT's Motor Sports Noise Environment Protection Policy (Dirt Track=85db Trackside/ride by). Compulsory EPA track side noise monitoring will be conducted. No machine under any circumstance is to be started before 9am.

## **TYRES**

NO NOBBY'S TYRES ON JUNIOR 125/250CC OR ANY SENIOR BIKES, otherwise as per GCR's. Trials or speedway pattern are ok.

## **CAMPING**

Camping is allowed at the track Friday/Saturday night must be organised prior with Race secretary.

## **CANTEEN**

**Canteen Facility's will be OPEN Sat and Sun.**

## **PRESENTATIONS**

Trophy presentations will take place at THE CANTEEN ASAP at the conclusion of racing on the Sunday.
